ICD's certified rehabilitation counselors, vocational counselors, vocational evaluators, instructors, and employment specialists provide these services:

- Diagnostic vocational evaluation, assessment, and career counseling
- Vocational improvement (pre-employment work adjustment)
- Occupational skills training in office technology, human services, food services, and building maintenance
- Job placement counseling and job retention supports
